Gaylord Community Schools is accepting applications for enrollment in the following grade levels from residents living in communities outside of the Gaylord Community School District:

Kindergarten: Unlimited Enrollment

1st Grade – 12th Grade: 5 openings in each grade level

All non-residents applying for enrollment under Schools of Choice must send a letter to the Superintendent's Office, 615 S. Elm St. Gaylord, MI 49735 or call 989-705-3080 to request an application. Indicate name, address, phone number, and grade level of student(s) in your letter. ***Deadline to apply for grades 1 through 12 is August 8, 2008. Deadline to apply for kindergarten is September 5, 2008.***

Gaylord Community Schools also has the following Career & Technical Education (Vocational) Program openings available for students for the 2008-09 school year:

- Accounting I & II
 - These courses are designed to develop the skills of accounting principles and theory.
- Intro to Automotive Technology
 - This course is designed to teach the basic automotive techniques in regards to the NATEF certification process.
- Automotive Technology I & II
 - These courses are designed to develop a broad familiarity with the automotive industry and NATEF task list.
- Advanced & Integrated Computer Applications
 - These computer courses incorporate all of the Microsoft Suite Software programs.
- Advanced & Culinary Arts
 - This course concentrates on cooking in the food service industry as related to restaurant service.
- Intro to Landscaping & Welding
 - This course is designed to teach the basic horticulture and landscaping/welding sciences techniques.
- Landscaping Welding I & II
 - This course is designed to provide an awareness of entrepreneurial opportunities in welding and landscaping fields.
- Cooperative Education
 - This course allows the student to work in a career related field while earning high school credit.
- Marketing I & II
 - These courses are designed to develop skills in major occupational areas of marketing.
- Child Development
 - This course examines personal readiness to become a parent and important issues related to raising healthy children.
