This document is available from GHS computers when you login under the N: drive in the GHS Media Center folder

Go to "My Computer"

Under your name is "GHS.Student on..." (if you expand that you will see it is the N: drive)

Click on "GHS.Student on..."

Go to GHS Media Center folder and click on "Research Databases"
