



Mitigation Measures for Face-to-Face Instruction







Facial coverings are mandatory



Hygiene

- Multiple hand sanitation stations are available
- Frequent hand washing is occurring
- Sharing of devices is minimized

- Social distancing is enforced

- Signage is increased






Screening

- Parent signed off for students at beginning of year

- Symptomatic students and staff are sent home

Testing

GCS coordinates with the Health Department of Northwest Michigan.





Responding to a positive case

- Communicate with Heath Department of Northwest Michigan
- Conduct contact tracing
- Follow flowchart for quarantine and isolation guidelines
- Follow communication and notification protocol

- No assemblies
- Meals are eaten in classroom or socially distanced situations





Athletics

We continue to follow MHSAA guidelines





Cleaning

- Cleaning has been increased in the evenings with the Clorox 360
- Desks are cleaned between uses
- High touch surfaces are frequently cleaned
- HVAC systems have been enhanced



Busing

- Mandatory face coverings
- Two students per seat
- No transfers
- Frequent deep cleaning
