March is here, and we are all very excited about the possibility of spring and better outside weather. It hasn't been a bad winter, but warm weather and longer days always seem to cheer everyone up.

Spring Break is scheduled for March 27-March 31, so we will not be having After School Care that week. We hope that you will be able to enjoy that extra time off with your children.

Just in case you didn't know, we have a "Caught Being Good" award for our students "caught" being helpful and kind during their time in our program. This award is meant to encourage the children to look for ways to make a positive impact in their world each day. Please be sure to praise your student when you see their certificate coming home with them.

Please be sure to let us know of any After School Care change of plans and schedules for your students at GIS, at SME, and at NOE, so we can adjust our daily class rosters. We also ask that you make sure to turn in any phone or address changes to the office, so that we can keep our emergency forms current.

All of the schools have implemented a "no toy or electronics" policy at school, and we enforce that policy here in our child care program as well. We cannot be responsible for lost or broken items, and so we ask that they not be brought out during their time here.

The February bills went out this week, so please be sure to let us know if you do not receive yours in the mail. Payments are due by March 20th, and they are due in full at that time or a \$10 late fee will be applied. This will be strictly enforced. You can pay with either cash, check, or credit card in the Board office or drop off a check or cash when you pick up your child.

We continue to remind you that we have many security protocols in place for our building:

- We keep our buildings locked at all times for your child's safety, so everyone must come to the
 front of NOE and SME and the Gym entrance at GIS to sign out your child. We will then bring
 them to you for pick-up.
- We will continue to check identification and cross reference emergency cards when an individual we do not recognize is picking up a child. So please bring your ID's with you. Again, this is for the safety of the children.
